Suzanne Warrena Richardson Laffoon, age 71 of Searcy and Little Rock, passed away peacefully Thursday, December 18, 2019 at the Advanced Care Hospital in Searcy. She was born February 5, 1948 in Lincoln Hospital in Detroit, Michigan to the late Warren and Mary Richardson. Suzanne grew up in Little Rock, but spent the majority of her life in Searcy. She was a member of Trinity Parish Church. She was preceded in death by her parents, daughter Amy Laffoon, sister Ellen Brown and brother Phillip Brown.
