Albert Dale English went to his heavenly home on September 7, 2020 in Searcy, Arkansas. He was born on Sunday, November 26th, 1939 in Searcy to Robert Dexter English and Minnie Belle Wyatt. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Searcy serving many years as an usher.

Dale's love for Searcy showed in his many contributions to the city. He served as Alderman on the Searcy City Council for 33 years beginning in 1987 until his passing. In addition, he served 20 years with the Searcy Fire Department and retired as Captain. He served in the Arkansas National Guard for 22 years retiring as Sergeant First Class. As a charter member, he served 30 years for the Searcy Girls Softball League. He was a member of the Arkansas Officials Association and served as a high school football official for 25 years.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Hazel Huntley English; two daughters, Kristy Parish (Donnie) and Tiffany English both of Searcy; two granddaughters Jennifer Pharaon (Shad) of Camas, Washington and Loren Brown (Jarod) of Judsonia; one grandson Wyatt Dale English of Searcy; one brother, Robert English of Texarkana, Texas; five great-grandchildren, two nieces and many lifelong friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents and brother, Winford English of Searcy.

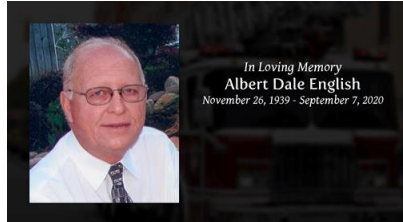
