Mr. Arnold "Glenn" Sanders of Alton, Virginia died Monday, October 7, 2013 at his home. He was born December 18, 1932 and was 80 years of age. He was the son of the late Robert Mark Sanders and Velma McGhee Sanders and is survived by his wife Harriett Yancey Sanders.

Mr. Sanders was a charter member of Dan River Ruritan Club and later transferred to the Turbeville Ruritan Club, having been a member of the Ruritans for 45 years. He was Dan River District Secretary for 32 years and was a Zone Governor for Zones 8 & 9, Halifax County. Mr. Sanders served in the U. S. Air Force for 4 years having served in the Korean Conflict.
