Bonnie Hurdle Bynum, 77, formerly of Searcy, passed away on August 18 at her home in Little Rock. She was born on January 30, 1941, in Marshall County, Mississippi. She graduated from Baptist School of Nursing and was a registered nurse for 50 years.
