



## Calvin H. Querry

May 13, 1938 - February 20, 2025

On Thursday, February 20 at 5:25 p.m. our Lord and Savior called His faithful and loving son home. Our father, Calvin Harvadean Querry passed through the Pearly Gates of Heaven for his eternal reward.

On May 13, 1938, Calvin H Querry was born to James F. and Frances C. (Bolls) Querry to complete their family of eight.

Calvin served his country in the Navy for 24 years, earning the title of Navy Diver Master Chief. During his time stationed in Hawaii, he met the first love of his life, Alice (Lupe) Querry. Their marriage welcomed three children, Calvin, Dean and Twany.

Upon his retirement from military service, our Lord called him to the Ministry of God, where he faithfully gave his heart and life to God's message and goodwill. Calvin served in the ministry for 48 plus years, as the pastor of several churches in Arkansas as well as a Missionary Minister in El Salvador and Guatemala. His life was also filled educating students at ASU-Searcy as the automotive instructor for 10 years.
