Carroll Ray James, 72, of Searcy, passed from this life on Sunday, December 10, 2023 at the John McClellan Veterans Hospital in Little Rock. He was born January 15, 1951 in Russell, Arkansas to the late Norman Ray James and Juanita (Childers) James.

On June 5, 1970 Carroll, or “CJ” as he was known to all, married his Bald Knob High School sweetheart, Lee Ann Pascoe. Soon after, he was drafted by the United States Army to serve in the Vietnam War. Their marriage spanned more than 53 years and included two daughters, five grandchildren, and one great grandchild on the way. 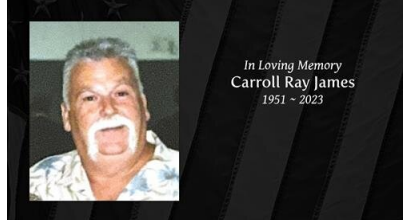
