



## Charles Edward Latina

Charles Edward Latina died on December 2, 2021 at home in Pangburn, Arkansas. He was born at home in Carpentersville, Illinois on September 16, 1931. Charles was the son of John and Eva (Loecholt) Latina.

Charles served with the U. S. Army during the Korean War. He was a proud veteran and honored all who served. When Charles returned, he married Glorianne M. Hopp of Carpentersville, Illinois. They celebrated 67 years of marriage in June. Charles' family always came first, and he was proud of all seven of his children.

Charles worked in construction. He was an exceptionally talented Carpenter and Mechanic. Charles owned his own service station and worked in construction in Illinois. Upon moving to Arkansas he built log homes and worked for Matthews Inc. until retirement. 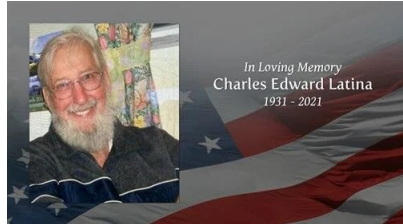
