He was the type of person who would give you the shirt off his back and ask you if you needed his pants too. I saw him sharing doughnuts with a homeless man pushing his belongings in a cart. He made loyal friends wherever he went. He lived life on his terms. He could have had an easier life, but he chose freedom to come and go as he pleased. He will be sorely missed by all who knew and loved him.

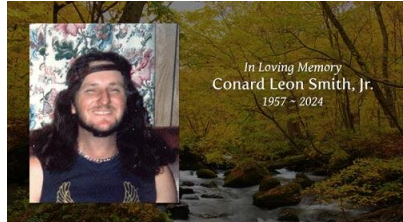
