Donald Sanders, affectionately known as “Sparky,” “Papa Smurf,” “Papa,” and “Grandpa Don,” was called home at the age of 88 on April 22, 2026, in Bald Knob, Arkansas. He was a big heart wrapped in a stubborn spirit, surrounded by love. A proud retired iron worker and pipeliner, Don’s craft built not only structures but also a legacy of strength and resilience. He had a big heart, an adventurous spirit, and a gift for storytelling.

Born on March 25, 1938 on ditch 13 in Bald Knob, Arkansas, to Sam and Mary (Elliot) Sanders, Don was a spirited individual who loved to whittle, fish, visit flea markets, and share stories.
