Dorothy "Dot" Yingling, 82, of Searcy, died after a brief illness on Wednesday, October 7, 2009. She was born in Hickory Ridge, Arkansas, on May 16, 1927, and was preceded in death by her parents, Dewitt and Lena Munger; a son, Phillip Yingling; and siblings Elvin Munger, F. D. She attended Harding College where she was selected as May Queen before graduating in 1948.
