Doyle Gene Byrd, 90, of Bald Knob passed peacefully from this world to be with his Savior on Sunday, December 22, 2024. He was born on October 9, 1934 in Judsonia, Arkansas. He is preceded in death by his parents, Walter and Lucille Byrd, and his first wife of 52 years, Georgia Byrd with whom he shared a lifetime of memories and love while they raised their two children, Randy Byrd and Su-Ellen Cooper. Doyle was a dedicated member of Central Baptist Church in Bald Knob where he was a trustee and served on various committees, including both building and finance. After his retirement as a mechanic from Texas Eastern, he concentrated on his truck business, Byrd's Chevy Truck Parts where he had a wide network of truck friends with whom he enjoyed swapping parts and stories. He retired after many years of service in the Bald Knob Fire Department, and also enjoyed participating in local AARP meetings. Doyle loved life and lived his to the fullest. Some of his happiest times were spent camping at Greer's Ferry Lake and "the cabin," vacationing with the family

where he loved to ride go-carts and zip-lines, playing cards, dominos, and Sequence, and fishing. In his later years, he spent mornings (and lots of afternoons) at the Market Café drinking coffee and telling tall tales with some of his many friends.
