Elizabeth L. Pittard Murry, resident of Searcy, Arkansas and formerly of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, died Monday, March 3, 2008. She was 94 years of age.

Mrs. Murry was born October 29, 1913 in Union County, New Mexico, a daughter of Robert Samuel and Lola Farris Pittard. Elizabeth excelled in basketball in high school in Des Moines, New Mexico. She attended college at Oklahoma A & M and returned to New Mexico to teach school.

In 1936 she married Bill Murry and they moved to Mississippi after WWII where he was a lawyer, a Church of Christ preacher, and a farmer. Elizabeth was a school teacher, A Bible School teacher, a Girl Scout leader, PTA president, and Opti-Mrs. President. She was an excellent seamstress and gardener. Most important to her was teaching her children Biblical truths, sewing, music and a life devoted to Christian womanhood.
