She was so upset when she couldn't attend church anymore because of health problems. She made quilts and gave them away to friends and family. She loved helping people.

She was preceded in death by her mother and father, Minnie and Charles Cox, two sisters, Minnie Lee Goodwin and Mary Ellen Watwood, one brother, Franklin Cox, a half-brother, Big Dewey Cox.
