Elmer Lee Greer, age 91 of Searcy, died Friday, March 31, 2017 in Searcy. He was born July 15, 1925 in Searcy to the late Lee and Nettie Greer. Mr. Greer was a 1943 graduate of Searcy High School; a World War II Veteran of the Army Air Corps where he served as a B-52 Gunner; owned and operated Searcy Frozen Foods for 46 years; worked for the Harding University Maintenance Department for 12 years; Searcy Parks and Recreation for 3 years; was a former member of the Searcy Lion's Club; and served as a Deacon at West Race Baptist Church for 37 years.
