Eugene Leon Boyce, 67, of Bald Knob, died Monday, July 30, 2012 in Little Rock. He was born March 4, 1945 in Gilroy, California a son of the late Dallas Frank and Luty Neal Boyce. He was a carpenter and a lawn service operator and a member of the Lone Star Missionary Baptist Church where he served as Deacon.
