“ I came to know the Waller family when my own family moved to Liberty Valley in 1963. Evelyn and her husband, Jessie, were foundational and active members of the Liberty Valley Missionary Church which was central to the farm community in which Evelyn was raised. She remained a life long anchor in community and church until her passing. We became acquainted when she invited me to sing with her children for a Sunday morning radio worship service sponsored by affiliated churches. I was immediately impressed with Evelyn’s confidence and organizational skills. She hosted many church services in her home during building renovations, held down a full time job at a local factory, maintained an orderly household with 3 teenagers and provided care to her aging parents in their home so they could remain independent until their passing. She knew how to manage her household and delegate to her children- I never heard one of them argue or complain. Evelyn did not ask, she directed. There was not much grey area in the way she thought or lived. Her tone was firm but not angry, loud, or disrespectful. For Evelyn, precision and organization were her friend. Her personal style was perfectly coiffed hair and classic tailored style. She was a pretty woman, neat and trim, who always looked put together well. There was no coquettish manipulation in her demeanor. She took life’s responsibilities seriously. She was bold, independent, and confident in her mannerisms and beliefs tempered with good manners and strong core values. She spoke her truth as she saw it. She conveyed a strong love for her family and community through actions of loyalty and service. She could indulge humor with a sparkle laugh and satisfied smile that revealed a warmth of spirit underneath an extraordinary work ethic. Her vice was speed- she drove the gravel roads fast! She was good natured and properly dismissive of anybody who tried to scold her or made joke comments about it. The only time I saw a sense of vulnerability was when she played her guitar for Jessie on Sunday afternoons. I appreciate the permission she gave by example to be a strong and bold woman if accompanied with good values. My husband, Phillip, recalls with fondness sharing childhood in the Valley with the Waller kids. His

fondest Christmas memory is when their families spent the day together and they all received bicycles. We spend decades putting together a puzzle we call life. Evelyn and Jessie- for us they came as a pair- are a treasured piece of our own puzzle. With Evelyn's passing that space is empty not to be filled again on this side of eternity.
