Frank Marion (Frankie) Davis of Bald Knob passed away the morning of June 13, 2012. Frankie succumbed to injuries sustained in a fall-related accident. He was born August 30, 1939 in Salina, Oklahoma to Marion Asa Davis and Nancy Smith Davis.

Proud of his Cherokee heritage, Frankie spent his early years as a commercial fisherman and lived with his family on a houseboat at the mouth of the Red River. He graduated from Laura Conner High School in Augusta, and received an honorable discharge from the Army National Guard of Arkansas after 6 years of service. He retired from Entergy where he was employed as a senior lineman for almost 30 years. He served his community in many ways including serving as Alderman for the City of Bald Knob, and assisted in the building of Kenyatta Haynes Park.

Frankie was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by Penny, his beloved wife of 46 years, children Dustin Davis, Shannon Davis (his wife Evelyn) and Whitney Brown (her husband Corey), grandchildren Corey (his wife Taylor) Davis, Kayla Davis, Kendal Davis, Michael Meade, Brandon Davis, Shelby Spencer, Autumn Spencer, and great-grand daughter Hynlee Davis. Surviving family also includes his sister Fannie Brown and numerous nieces and nephews.
