Gerald Glenn Morgan, age 84, died Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2009. He was born June 25, 1925 in Piggott, AR, the son of Albert and Lela Mae Morgan. He was a member of the College Church of Christ in Searcy, AR. He was a graduate of Piggott High School in 1943. He was a graduate of the University of Oklahoma College Of Pharmacy and was an active registered pharmacist for 56 years. He served in the U.S. Navy in the WWII and served as a 1st Lt. in the U.S. Army in the Korean War. He served on the Crowley's Ridge Academy and Crowley's Ridge College Boards. While living in Corning, he served on the Corning Chamber of Commerce, the Industrial Development Board, the Corning Savings and Loan Board. He was a great servant to his family, church and community. He served on the Harding University Development Council and was passionate about golf and all Harding University Bison Athletics.
