Hilton H. Emde, age 88 of Judsonia died August 13, 2008. He was born in Judsonia September 27, 1919, the son of Harry and Lottie Prince Emde.

Mr. Emde was retired from Texas Eastern Transmission Corporation having worked there 25 years. He was a 32nd Degree Mason, a member of Anchor Lodge #384, and served as a board member of the Judsonia Public Housing Authority for 38 years. Mr. Emde was a member of First Baptist Church in Judsonia and attended the Men II Sunday School Class.
