Hiram Vernon "H.V." Gill, 82, of Searcy, passed from this life on Thursday, July 20, 2023 at Unity Health in Searcy. He was born September 1, 1940 in Portia, Arkansas (Lawrence County) a son of the late Olus and Rebecca Marie (Kissee) Gill. H.V. was a long time member of the St. Paul Methodist Church in Searcy where served on numerous boards and was active in Gideons. In 1964, Mr. Gill began a career with the Soil Conservation Service as a Soil Scientist. Upon his retirement in 1996, he became a Soil Classifier for the Department of Health and performed perk tests for many years. In earlier years, he enjoyed deer hunting and the comradery of deer camp. He enjoyed golfing and bowling and once bowled a perfect 300 game. He was an avid St. Louis Cardinals and Arkansas Razorback fan and a member of both the Searcy Lions Club and the Monticello Lions Club.
