Hubert Larkin Lee, 93, of Beebe went home to be with the Lord on February 19, 2017. He was born October 4, 1923 in Delaplaine, Arkansas to the late Fred James and Florence Ellen (Brown) Lee. Hubert left a legacy of Christian service behind him. He spent 57 years as a pastor, was a seminary professor, and a member of the Westview Baptist Church in Searcy. 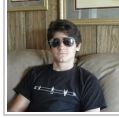
