Dr. J. Aaron Little, resident of Searcy, passed away on Friday, August 29, 2008 at the age of 45.

Dr. Little was born June 29, 1963 in Little Rock, Arkansas, the son of James Robert and Barbara Ann Cooper Little. He was a graduate of Heber Springs High School, where he played football and for many years participated in the "Old Timers" games. He was a graduate of Hendrix College in Conway.
