Jeannette Norris Baggett, 83, of Searcy, died Wednesday, January 9 at her home in Searcy. She was born May 9, 1929 in Plain Dealing, Louisiana, the daughter of Roscoe and Ruth Norris.

Jeannette was a charter member of the West Side Church of Christ, where she taught 6th grade children and later the ladies Bible class. She is a 1950 graduate of Harding College where she was a member of the Alpha Honors Society. She was a past sponsor of the GATA girls social club. Jeannette worked as the office manager of the Medical Arts Clinic, which merged in 1973 with the Searcy Medical Clinic to become the Searcy Medical Center.
