

## Jerry Wayne Case

August 21, 1949 - April 1, 2024

Jerry Wayne Case, 74, of Bald Knob, passed away Monday, April 1, 2024, at the VA Hospital in Little Rock after a lengthy illness. He was born August 21, 1949, in Lepanto, Arkansas. Jerry was the son of the late Gene and Ava (Johnson) Case. He was a member of the Bald Knob Church of Christ. Jerry was a 1967 graduate of Bald Knob High School. From there he went on to serve his country in the United States Army, until he was wounded in the Vietnam War in October 1969. Jerry graduated with his master's degree from Harding University and went on to serve the citizens of Bald Knob as mayor for several years. He loved politics and baseball. His favorite past times were gardening, traveling, watching the Boston Red Sox and spending time with his boys.

Jerry was preceded in death by his oldest son, Jeremy Shane Case; his parents; one brother, Everett Case; one sister, Lawana Johnston; and one sister-in-law, Pat Case.

Jerry is survived by two sons, Shannon Matthew Case and Jerrod Scott Case; one granddaughter, Lexie Robinson (Jacob); and four great grandchildren; one brother, Travis Case; one sister, Gladys Franklin and one sister-in-law, Betty Carol Roetzel; the mother of his children, Beverly, as well as a number of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

Funeral services will be conducted on Friday, April 5, 2024 at 3:00 p.m. at the Powell Funeral Home Chapel in Bald Knob. Visitation will precede the service, beginning at 2:00 p.m. Interment, with military honors, will follow in the Carter

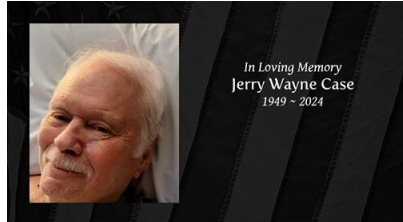
