Jimmie Louis Johnson "Red" was born on June 20, 1939, to Buster and Freda Johnson in Searcy, Arkansas. Red was the third of 13 children Buster and Freda would have. Red was never one to deliver a speech or sermon on how to live or treat others. His life showed how to do that. He volunteered to take groups to Puerto Rico to support Joe and Velma Cuellar. He volunteered to take doctors to Mexico and provide medical care in extremely rural areas. He would drive to the community in Mexico pulling a trailer with the medical supplies and food. Red would cook while dentist and medical doctors pulled teeth, set broken bones, and performed surgeries.

Red will be missed by all who know him. Most of all by his family who truly loved him. We know that he has gone ahead to a place we are all headed and we look forward to seeing him again.
