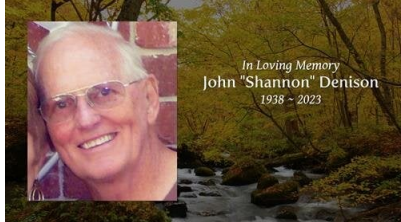
He is preceded in death by his parents James and Glenda Denison and his brother Russell Denison (Gwen).
