To this union they were blessed with one daughter. He was one of the first African Americans to graduate from Bald Knob High School in 1966. After high school he joined the United State Air Force. He was honorably discharged after serving four years. He then worked for Arkansas Power and Light as a lineman. He learned many electrical skills while working for the power company, which he used to assist many people in the community.

Kenny loved maintaining his yard and was very meticulous when it came to mowing it. He enjoyed sports, fishing, cooking wild game, and hunting. He especially enjoyed hunting with his father. He was known for handing out candy to children in the neighborhood. He also enjoyed spending time with his family and friends in Augusta, Bald Knob, Kensett, and Searcy, AR.

He departed this life on September 12, 2022 at Unity Health-White County Medical Center. He was preceded in death by his father; Sylvester White Sr. his mother; Della Mae Edwards White; and four brothers; Phillip White Sr., Marvin White Sr., Sylvester White Jr., and Donald White.

He leaves to cherish his memory, two daughters Christina and Chervonne (Paul) both of Searcy, AR; Two

“ Sorry to be a little late writing this. I just got back from a week-long trip to another state. My sincerest condolences to Kenneth's entire family.

Kenneth and I were friends even before our high school at Bald Knob was integrated. We attended high school together during our senior year and we were on the football and basketball team together. We haven't seen much of one another since high school and I count that as a loss.

In my eyes Kenneth was a race relations pioneer in the way that he handled himself during our football and basketball games. Particularly basketball. In 1966, integrated teams were not viewed favorably in a lot of places. We would sometimes enter a Crackerbox gym in one of the small country towns where we played, and there would be a chorus of racially motivated comments raining down on us. Some were not too bad but others were outright hateful. Kenneth always handled this with a grace and composure that I know I could not have displayed.

The town of Hazen called ahead of a scheduled game and asked that if we came not to bring "him" meaning Kenneth. I was proud of the rest of our team when we voted unanimously to forfeit that game. Man have things come a long way since then. We own a lot of thanks to people like Kenneth who were willing to face the evil and continue to make progress.

I thought that Kenneth was a great athlete. He almost always controlled the opening tip against opponents who were as much as seven inches taller than him. He was quick and fast and had a great knowledge of the game. We didn't win too many games but I thought that we worked very well together as a team.

I was most impressed by the peace, composure, and self-control that Kenneth displayed during his normal life. I haven't known very many people who were as pleasant to be around as Kenneth.

May he rest in peace.

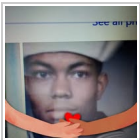
