



## Larry Allen Lunday

June 26, 1950 - January 15, 2026

Larry Allen Lunday, born June 26, 1950, departed this life on January 15, 2026 — at the age of 75.

Larry grew up in Augusta, AR and attended ASU Jonesboro. Larry was a hard worker who worked in a local grocery store at the age of 12. After college, he worked for Ligons Grocery and co-owned Lunday's Building Supply in Augusta, managed Ridout Lumber Co. in Searcy, and retired from Entergy Corp. after 26 years.

Larry was an avid reader, possessed a great knowledge of WWII, Civil War and all things history. Along with his dad and brother, he helped discover Fitzhugh Woods Civil War Battle Field outside Augusta, AR and was instrumental in procuring the Civil War monument marker for that battleground. Larry was on the Searcy Library Board and served as president, a member of Civil War Roundtable, White County Historical Society, and Sons of Thunder. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Searcy. Recently, he fulfilled his bucket list by visiting his favorite author, Ernest Hemingway's, home in Key West, Florida. Larry never met a stranger and will be missed by many.

Larry was preceded in death by his parents, Herbert and Marion Lee Lunday of Augusta, a grandson, Lane Lunday, and special brother-in-law, Jerry Smith

of Stuttgart. He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Evelyn Hamilton Lunday, of Searcy, a son, Jon Lunday (Misty) of Searcy, and their children, Samuel and Rhett Glasser, and a daughter, Lori Coleman, (TJ) of Mountain View, a sister, Carol Smith, of Stuttgart, a brother, Herbert (Mary Beth) of Nixa, MO., precious nieces and nephews, and many friends.

Services will be conducted on Sunday, January 18, 2026, at 2:30pm at Searcy First Assembly of God. Visitation will precede the service, beginning at 1:30pm. Interment will follow at Augusta Memorial Park in Augusta, Arkansas.
