Larry Floyd Robinson, 82, of Bradford, departed this life on Monday, February 17, 2025 in the comfort of his home. He was born September 10, 1942 in Lepanto, Arkansas a son of the late Floyd and Helen (Tingle) Robinson. Larry was widely known for his assistance to veterans of White and Prairie Counties. He served as the White County Veterans Service Officer for 25 years and was currently serving as Prairie County Veterans Service Officer.
