Lila Richards, age 96 of Searcy, died Sunday, June 10, 2012 in Searcy. Miss Richards was born August 27, 1915 in Bald Knob, Arkansas, the daughter of Ludie and Obed Richards.

She completed high school at Bald Knob High School in May, 1933. Following high school, she completed three years of nursing school, graduating December 8, 1936, from St. Bernard Hospital School of Nursing, Jonesboro, Arkansas.

Miss Richards continued to work and live in Jonesboro, until she accepted an assignment with the Veterans Administration Service in 1940. During her 35 years of service, she was assigned to hospitals in various locations, including Topeka, Kansas, where she retired in 1976. In 1957, she took educational leave to study in anesthesia for two years, graduating from St. Francis School of Anesthesia, Peoria, Illinois. She served as a Nurse Anesthetist after 1957. She is survived by two nephews, Eugene Steward and his wife Jean of Bald Knob, Carl Steward and his wife Helen of Bald Knob; and three nieces, Katherine Odom of Florida, Irene Brown of Searcy, and Freda Holder of North Little Rock. She is preceded in death by her parents; one brother; and three sisters.
