Lisa was a lover of people who made friends effortlessly and genuinely no matter the circumstance. She radiated goodness to all who knew her and her kindness never found its limit. She loved without judgement and gave whatever she had to anyone in need. She was very close to her family and her family loved her dearly.

Lisa's signature look was her short cropped dark hair (never dyed!!) and richly tanned skin in a long, sleeveless summer dress. She exuded joy, fun and spontaniety and loved the sun, the sand, and the ocean; particularly the ocean they experienced during her husband, Mark Seufer's tour of duty in Guam.
