



## Mabel Ernestine Carlo

June 12, 1923 - March 19, 2013

Mabel Ernestine "Ernie" Carlo, 89, of Searcy, Arkansas, died at 11:40 a.m., March 19, 2013, at her home in Searcy.

She was born June 12, 1923, in Scott, Ohio, to the late William Isaac and Mabel Agnes (Getts) Lake.
