Majors P. Pickens, age 95, left this earth for his eternal home on April 22, 2024. Majors was born May 20, 1928, to Robert & Grace (Majors) Pickens. He was raised on a farm west of Searcy on Panther Creek. He graduated from Searcy High School in 1947. He was drafted into the army in 1951 and served in Korea in 1952. Soon after returning from his military service, he met Virginia House at a church camp meeting. They were married 55 years and raised two daughters.

Majors retired in 1993 after working 46 years at First National Bank where his attention to detail and his honest character served the bank well.

Majors was a lifetime member of Searcy Church of the Nazarene where he served many years as church treasurer and a member of the church board.

He is preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Virginia; his only brother, Gerald Pickens; five sisters-in-laws; and four brothers-in-laws.
