



Marc Thurston Crain

July 13, 1966 - July 4, 2024

Marc Thurston Crain, died July 4, 2024, at the age of 57, in Big Bear Lake, California. Born on July 13, 1966, in Little Rock, Arkansas, Marc's life was marked by moments of joy as well as considerable challenges.

Marc grew up in Searcy, Arkansas enjoying a childhood filled with simple pleasures and strong friendships. He spent his early years riding three-wheelers, exploring the outdoors with friends, playing Little League baseball, Pee-Wee Football and recreation basketball. Summers were often spent at Greers Ferry Lake, where Marc enjoyed time with his family, cousins, and close friends. As a senior in high school, Marc joined his Searcy Lions teammates in finishing as runners-up in the state championship in football. Marc additionally was an avid tennis player in high school and walked on to play tennis at the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville.

Marc later attended the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, earning a bachelor's degree. Music played a valuable role in his life, providing an outlet for his emotions and creativity. He spent countless hours recording and playing, finding peace in the tunes. Marc enjoyed snow skiing, which initially led him to Avon, Colorado. He later settled in Big Bear Lake, California, where he found a community more compatible with his lifestyle.

Marc shared a close relationship with his grand-dad, Paul W. Crain, until his grand-dad's death in 2007, even living with him in an attached apartment for a time. His relationship with his grand-dad was a source of strength and comfort for Marc.

In September 1989, Marc accepted Jesus as his Savior during the Billy Graham Crusade at War Memorial Stadium in Little Rock. His decision brings his family comfort and hope, as they hold fast to Jesus Christ's words in John 10:27-28: "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of My hand."

Marc was preceded in death by his parents, Larry Paul Crain, Sr., and Janett McNeil Crain. He is survived by his two brothers, Larry Crain, Jr. and his wife Joy, and Chris Crain and his wife Jennifer as well as many nieces and nephews. Although Marc's struggles often strained relationships, his family cherishes their positive memories of Marc.

A visitation will be held at 1:30 p.m., followed by a memorial service at 2:30 p.m., on Thursday, July 18, 2024, at the Searcy First Methodist Church, 304 N Main St, Searcy, Arkansas.

Marc Thurston Crain's life was marked by moments of joy as well as significant challenges. We honor Marc, who navigated life's struggles, always loved by his parents, brothers, and community. His journey serves as a reminder of the importance of compassion, understanding and perseverance for those facing mental health challenges.
