Marvin Harvey, 82, of Russell, went to be with the Lord, Monday, February 10, 2014 at his home while surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Russell March 4, 1931 a son of the late George and Eva Wells Harvey. Marvin was a supervisor with the NIBCO Corp. before his retirement.
