Mary Riggs Reed passed from this life on September 21, 2020 at her home in Searcy, Arkansas. She was preceded in death by her parents, Harry and Alice Riggs, her beloved in-laws, Raymond Reed and Doris Reed-Rousseau, and a sister-in-law, Sharon Riggs.
