



Maxine Iola Jones Rice

March 3, 1944 - September 14, 2013

Maxine Iola Jones Rice, age 69, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Saturday, September 14, 2013, after a courageous battle with cancer that weakened her body, but never her faith in Jehovah God and her deep and caring love for others.

She leaves to treasure her memory, her loving and devoted husband John Davis Rice of their home in Wake Forest, NC. They would have celebrated their 51st wedding anniversary on September 29, 2013.
