



## Meredith Garland Dixon

December 2, 1923 - August 11, 2013

Meredith G. Dixon, 89, of Danville, VA, died August 11. He was born in Halifax County on Dec. 2, 1923 to Bernard Garland Dixon and Thelma Blair Compton Dixon. Meredith graduated from Wilson Memorial High School, South Boston, in 1941 where he played baseball and basketball. He served in the US Army during WWII as a member of the 3014th Ordinance Base Automotive Maintenance Company in England and France. He spent his entire career with Virginia Power (now Dominion Resources) in Richmond, retiring in 1988. He was a Certified Master Gardener, an avid Boston Red Sox fan, an active member of Bon Air Baptist Church, Richmond and most recently, First Baptist Church, Danville.
