This assignment comes with a huge sign-on bonus, a reunion with family and friends she has not seen in a long time. Job security is exactly 110 percent. Her new mission takes her to a wonderful place where she will be socializing, writing, singing, painting, crafting, worshiping and praising to her hearts content. Music, laughter and love are guaranteed and the food is delicious. She left detailed instructions for her family and friends to celebrate her earthly mission which has now been completed.

Micah Holden, of Searcy, Ar., died Monday July 27 after a long battle with colon cancer. She was born on Aug. 20, 1969 in Searcy, the daughter of Tommy and Pam Vandiver Green.

She graduated from Lake Hamilton High School with the class of 1987. Micah later attended beauty school and began a successful career. On Jan. 27, 1990 she married her sweetheart, David Holden. They were blessed with two children, Thomas Ford and Emmeline Claire who brought them much joy. In her spare time, Micah developed a passion for creating her own artistic style of painting and unique crafting. Her relationship with Jesus Christ was the foundation of her every action and was evident in her artwork.

Micah's memory will be cherished by her loving husband, David Holden of Searcy, two precious children, Ford and Claire both of Searcy; dedicated
