Milburn Gerald McKenzie of Guy, Arkansas, formerly of Searcy, passed away Saturday October 27, 2012. He was born July 5, 1930 in Marked Tree, Arkansas to Everett and Pearl Alexander McKenzie. Milburn worked as a route salesman for Compton Candy Company and Owatonna Tool Company of Searcy, retiring from both.
