Nancy Ann Mason, 85, of Bald Knob, departed this life on Saturday, February 1, 2025 in the comfort of her home. She was born in White County on December 7, 1939 a daughter of the late Clyde and Blanche (Roseau) Cloyes. She held a Master's degree in Administration and served the Bald Knob Public School District in various key roles over the course of 34 years. Nancy worked as Secretary to the Principal for several years and went on to serve as the Federal Coordinator which monitored Migrant Programs. She was instrumental in writing the grant for the Bald Knob Kindergarten and Daycare. Mrs. Mason was very active and involved, not only in her profession, but her church and community as well. She served as President of the Arkansas Federal Coordinator's Association, President of the Bald Knob Garden Club, long-time board member of the Bald Knob Chamber of Commerce, the Bald Knob Senior Center, the Bald Knob Country Club, that she and her late husband helped establish, the Homefest Planning Committee, the L.J. Steward Addition to Shady Grove Cemetery Board and President of the EMW Board at the Bald Knob United Methodist Church, where she was a life time member. For her community involvement and leadership, Nancy received the Bald Knob Citizen of the Year Award in 2009. She remained very active in her later years, teaching exercise classes to the elderly at her church. Although Nancy enjoyed staying busy and serving others, her family was her joy. She is survived by a son, Monty Mason and wife Stacey; a daughter, Lisa

Treat and husband Gary; 2 grandchildren, Anna Neeper and husband Stephen and Daniel Treat and wife Katie; 5 great-grandchildren, Devyn Wooten, Marshall Neeper, Ivy Neeper, Dani Treat and Remi Treat as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
