In loving memory of Nikolaos Zaharopoulos - January 21, 1945 - March 10, 2024

Nikolaos Zaharopoulos, born in Xrisovo, Greece, age 79, peacefully passed after a year-long courageous battle with cancer in his home surrounded by family on the beautiful Sunday afternoon of March 10, 2024.

“Nick” was raised in the village of Xrisovo, Greece. As a teen, his family moved to Athens where he attended film school, worked on numerous sets of famous Greek films, and enlisted in the Greek Army. He then married his spouse, Georgia, in 1969, and together they came to the United States of America, where they first settled in Cape Girardeau, MO. Upon arriving to the US, he was offered a job to work as a behind-the-scenes technician with Walt Disney Production Studios in California. Despite the offer, his heart kept him in southeast Missouri, where many of his family had settled in the years prior. He was described as an “innovative entrepreneur,” who began many businesses including restaurants, a pastry shop, television production studios, an electronics retail store, and was involved in Amway for many years. He also became a proud United States citizen in 1976 (the bi-centennial year, in which he was very honored). Nick and his family lived in Sikeston, MO in their early years. They later moved to Memphis, TN, and then to Jonesboro, AR. Upon retirement, Nick and Georgia moved to Searcy, AR, to be closer to family.

Through his endeavors, he met and befriended many lifelong friends and colleagues. Nick never met a stranger, and was always willing to help, no matter the circumstances. Nick was a big dreamer and a hard worker. Many would say he was ahead of his time, as he was always coming up with new ideas and ways to improve whatever situations or problems he saw in his environment. Some of his best ideas were formed with a ball-point pen on a restaurant napkin. In most recent years, he thoroughly enjoyed long walks and fitness, which included tracking his steps and visiting with any neighbor lucky enough to be outside. Nick was a very proud grandfather, who loved to brag on his beautiful granddaughters and their many accomplishments.

Nick is survived by his wife, Georgia Zaharopoulos of Searcy AR, his children, Steve Zaharopoulos of Tarpon Springs FL, Pete (Katherine) Zaharopoulos of Springhill TN, and JoAn (Clayton) Edwards of Searcy AR; his granddaughters, Christin, Vivi, and Lydia and great-granddaughter Rachel; his siblings, Martha (Ted) Kappis of Jackson MS, and Aleca (John) Lazaridis of Tampa FL. He is preceded in death by his parents, Stavros and Yianoula Zaharopoulos, and grandson, Brandon Edwards.
