Nita Allen Cochran was born to James Marshall and Margie Nell Allen May 18, 1957 in Tupelo, Mississippi. After living in MS, TX, Australia, TN, Boston and for the last 23 years in Searcy, she passed away on May 31, 2016. Survived by her husband, Ross (Searcy), her children, Chris (Bentonville, AR), Allen (Nashville, TN) and Hannah (Searcy); mother, Margie Clark (Searcy); brothers, Marshall (Kris) Allen (Nashville, TN), Stan (Amy) Allen of Paducah, KY, and sister Jan (Kevin) Smith (Gadsden, AL); and numerous nephews and nieces. Nita directed Court Appointed Special Advocates of White County for five years and with her husband, directed Camp Tahkodah from 2004-2011. 

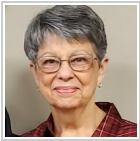
