Nora Pauline (Lynch) Jones, former resident of Judsonia, Arkansas, left us to sit at the feet of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on July 3rd, 2025, at Beebe Retirement Center, in Beebe, Arkansas. She was 90 years old. Nora was born in Blackton, Arkansas, on September 22, 1934 to Dudley Logan and Zoria (West) Lynch. She went to Brinkley High School and graduated from there. Nora and her beloved husband Bob, were united in marriage on October 15th, 1953. They were married until Bob's death in 1997. Nora was a champion biscuit maker, and worked at Hardee's in Searcy for approximately 25 years. She would get up very early almost every day and make the drive to Searcy to make biscuits from scratch. She often won biscuit making contests and had the trophies to prove it. She also had customers that would come in for breakfast, and if she happened to be off that day, would leave and come back on a day she was working. She was just that good. Nora loved to read, do word searches, and work in her garden and her flowers. She was an excellent cook, and could whip up a table full of food in a moments notice. She loved Thanksgiving and Christmas, and would cook a feast every year for her family. Those times gathered around her table, were some of the best times and memories of our lives. It just made her happy to be with her family. She loved, LOVE. She spent time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren and made memories with them that will last a lifetime. She is preceded in death by her husband Bob, her parents, and 12 brothers and sisters.

Nora is survived by her 4 children; Sharon Martin (Searcy); Steve Jones (Hot Springs), Jennifer Merritt (David) Greers Ferry, and John (Kim) Jones of Judsonia, seven grandchildren; Amy, Jamie, Nora, Cory, Dustin, Trace, and Ethan; and nine great grandchildren; Coree, Cade, Camdyn, Rosalie, Jasmine, Banks, Baker, Reese and Asher.
