Norman (Bud) Hicks, 82, of Bald Knob, died Monday, June 25, 2007 in Lawrenceville, Georgia. He was born February 6, 1925 in Russell a son of the late Samuel Aaron and Bertha Jane Winters Hicks. Bud was a life-long farmer and enjoyed tending his cattle and walking over the farm. He bought his first calf when he was 9 years old with strawberry picking money that started the cattle herd he kept until he retired at 75 years old. Bud joined the Navy at 19 and served on the USS Hector in the Pacific for 2 years. His tour of duty took him to Japan, Guam and the Hawaii Islands.
