Pauline Mason, 99, of Velvet Ridge, Arkansas passed away Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at Unity Health Medical Center in Searcy, Arkansas. She was born October 1, 1921 in Dripping Springs, Arkansas to the late Otis and Roxie (King) Tuggle. She was the last living sibling of 12 children born to Otis and Roxie. Some of our favorite memories as a family include listening to her stories, eating at her table hearing the song how many biscuits did you eat this morning, and watching her gather her money and gift at Christmas gatherings. She would also be waving from her rocking chair on the porch as you would leave her house. Some described her as invincible, timeless, and most definitely a treasure.
