He was a tribal member of the Caddo Indian Nation and great-great-grandson of the great Anadarko Indian Chief, Jose Maria. Those who knew him remember his tenacious work ethic, loving spirit, and his overwhelming generosity. The hole in our lives will never be filled, and we will miss him dearly.
