



## Rapha Jean Campbell

February 19, 1933 - July 26, 2020

Rapha Jean Campbell, 87, of Russell Arkansas, passed away Sunday, July 25, 2020 in Little Rock, Arkansas. Rapha Jean was born in Russell on February 19, 1933 to Ralph Lea and Dorothy Harper Pearce. Jean graduated from Russell High School where she played basketball. She attended the former Benton Harbor Junior College (now known as Lake Michigan College) where she studied business and accounting. Jean married Justin Schnebly in 1951. After Justin's unexpected death in 1962, she married Thomas Campbell in 1964. Throughout her life, Jean worked part time but devoted most of her time to being a homemaker, mother, and grandmother. While living in Michigan Jean spent her time raising her children and supporting them in their many activities. She was a scout Mom, a sports Mom, and a music Mom. Jean was also an active member of the Order of the Eastern Star before returning to Russell in the early 1980's. Living in Russell, Jean was an original member of the Russell School Restoration Committee where she held many key positions. Jean attended the Russell United Methodist Church. Jean was preceded in death by her first and second husband, Justin Leo Schnebly (1964) and Thomas Edward Campbell (1989), brother, Don Lea (2012) brother, Roger Lea (2016), her mother, Dorthy (Harper) Pearce and her father, Ralph Lea.
