Ricky Paul Reid, 72, of Searcy, passed from this life on Wednesday, September 13, 2023 at UAMS in Little Rock. He was born September 30, 1950 in Conway, Arkansas, a son of the late Billy Don Reid Sr and Geneva Reid Avra. Ricky was a member of St. Paul Global Methodist Church in Searcy. He graduated from Conway High School and joined the Army soon after graduation and then the National Guard. After completing his service, he and Pam married and soon moved to Camden where Ricky worked in sales for many years before his career brought them to Searcy.
