And in the months since his cancer diagnosis, he joked about all the things that he could now do that would not kill him...one does not worry about that extra piece of pie or southern fried chicken anymore. My father enjoyed the care-free life of watching his beagles run and listening to them "sing" when they would jump a rabbit. And given 6-12 months to live from his original diagnosis, it was not enough to take him to the next rabbit season. His wish was to watch his beagles run and listen to them "sing" one more time...and he did...thereby, outliving the doctor's prognosis. My father understood the term service to his country as he served in war alongside his brethren. Now his casket in death will be draped with a flag to show that honor. My father knew what it was to be wrapped around a pinkie, as he had one daughter who often had him as so. However, now she no longer will. We will say good-bye to my father on Friday January 9, 2009 in Halifax, VA, the place of his birth with the internment afterwards alongside his father.
